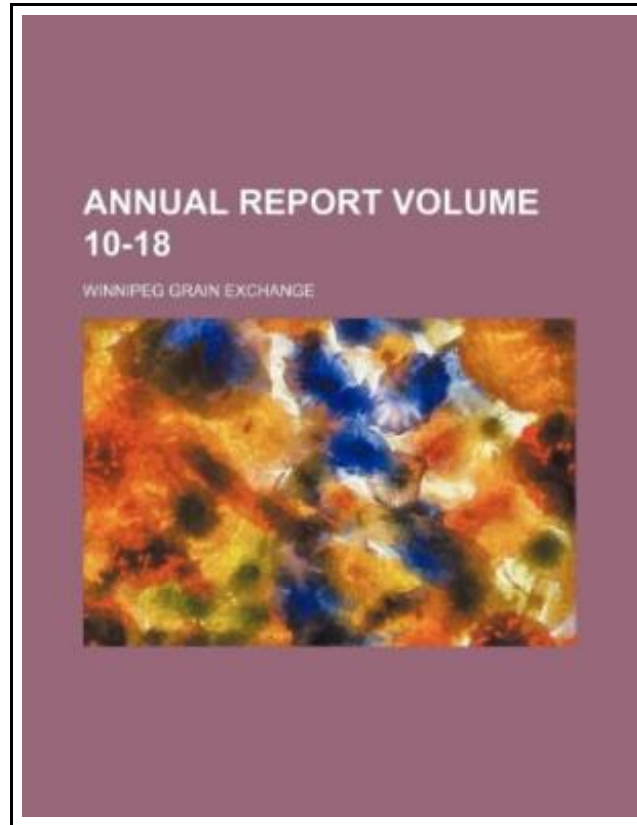

Fortunately the quantity of wheat inspected as rejected was very small and in consequence the Council did not further press the matter. TELEGRAPH RATES. In August last, the Council appointed a Committee to interview the C. P. R. telegraph officials and endeavor to have them open a telegraph office in the Exchange building and also to endeavor to secure a reduction on the current rates for grain messages. The Committee urged the matter upon the Winnipeg Superintendent who informed them that the General Superintendent was expected to arrive in the city shortly after that time when the whole matter could be taken up. The General Superintendent has not yet appeared upon the scene and no satisfactory result has followed the Committees representations either as to the reduction in rates or in the establishment of an office in the Exchange building.
