The historical background set the scene for the growth of the town from 1650 to the present (2013), by looking, examining and analysing the town mainly from an Architectural and Urban Planning perspectives. This has been achieved by dissecting the town into its principal components which come together, and is unified in a comprehensive dramatic whole, which includes Topography, Urban Planning, Architecture and Location.
